- 6. Which U.S. mountain range is most like the Alps?
- 7. Find Georgia on the U.S. map and notice the location of mountains, foothills and plains. Look also at Handout 1.3 to make a comparison of the physical features of both Georgia and Germany. Describe how they compare. Finally, describe how Germany's geography compares with that of your own state.
