<b>Bonn</b> Medieval residence of the Elector and Archbishop of Cologne, from 1948–1991 capital of the FRG. Today still seat of 6 ministries: Federal Town. University. Birthplace of Beethoven	<b>Weimar</b> Former capital of Sachsen-Weimar, historic centre of artists, poets (Goethe, Schiller), philosophers	<b>Hitzacker</b> Summer festivals of Chamber Music in Schleswig-Holstein
<b>Potsdam (Brandenburg)</b> Prussian royal castles (Sanssouci), parks, film museum	<b>Nuremberg (Nürnberg)</b> Historic Free Town of the Empire, rich and famous centre of arts and handicrafts, Dürer, Nazi conventions, 1946 tribunal	<b>Bochum</b> Theatre and music festival 'Ruhrtriennale', rich industrial centre
<b>Düsseldorf (North Rhine Westphalia)</b> Fairs, fashion, heavy trade, birth place of Heinrich Heine	<b>Augsburg</b> Antic Roman foundation, second eldest German city, Free Town of the (medieval) Empire, rich cultural offer, Fugger-colony (first charitable quarters in medieval Germany)	<b>Essen</b> Industrial city (steal from Krupp), fairs, 'Ruhrtriennale' (theatre and music)
<b>Hanover (Lower Saxony)</b> Royal castles, parks, fairs (Expo)	<b>Cologne (Köln)</b> Antic Roman military camp, medieval trade center, seat of Elector and Archbishop of Cologne, roman churches, gothic cathedral, fairs, rich cultural offers	<b>Oberhausen</b> International Documentary Film Festival; castle, rich cultural offer
<b>Dresden (Saxony)</b> Saxonian historic art centre, royal palaces, churches, theatres, opera house	<b>Heidelberg</b> Medieval famous ruin of electoral palace, historic university, rich offer	<b>Worpswede</b> Historic Centre of painters (Jugendstil, Expressionism), galleries
<b>Schwerin (Mecklenburg-Western-Pomerania)</b> Ducal palace, summer open air festival, parks	<b>Leipzig</b> Historic rich trade and fair centre, cultural offer, famous Thomaner choir (Bach)	<b>Erlangen</b> Jazz-Festival, eldest south German baroque theatre, galleries

North European film festivals, international chamber music festival	<b>Dachau</b> Historic Centre of painters (Naturalism and expressionism), first concentration camp in Nazi-time (March 1933), nowadays memorial
<b>München (Bavaria)</b> Seat of medieval archbishops, of Bavarian Electors, later kings, rich cultural metropolis, palaces, churches, cathedral, universities, parks, October-beer-festival	<b>Würzburg</b> Mozart-Festival, seat of princely bishops, medieval fortress, cultural historic rich centre	<b>Murnau</b> Historic centre of painters 'Der blaue Reiter' (expressionism), castle, music festival
<b>Erfurt (Thuringia)</b> Historic cathedral-festival, religious events, wine festivals	<b>Frankfurt</b> Rich cultural historic Free Town of the Empire, coronation town of German emperors, parks, museums-riverside-festival, birthplace of Goethe, European Central Bank, trade centre	<b>Hof</b> International Short Film Festival, churches, historic seat of the medieval governor of the Empire
<b>Bremen (Free Town of the Hanse)</b> World harbour, world trade place, rich cultural centre, Grimm's fairy tales: "Bremen's town musicians"		<b>Recklinghausen</b> Theatre and youth theatre, dance festival with art exhibitions "Ruhrfestspiele", historic buildings
<b>Hamburg (Free Town of the Hanse)</b> Germany's biggest world harbour, world trade place, rich cultural centre, first large open air animal park "Hagenbeck"		<b>Kassel</b> Historic residence town of the Counts of Hessa, castles, parks, theatre, Opera, world famous contemporary art exhibition 'Documenta'
<b>Mainz (Rhineland-Palatine)</b> Historic seat of Elector and Archbishop of Mainz, Churches, Castle, museums, media		
<b>Stuttgart (Baden-Württemberg)</b> Historic baroque residence of the kings of B-W. Rich cultural city. International ballet and opera. Museums, factories of Daimler-Benz.
